The following terminology and data explanations should help clarify the numbers and percentages found in this report.

### TERMINOLOGY

**October Count** The number of students enrolled at a school and included in the official count sent to the Colorado Department of Education (CDE). Students attending Ascent, Crossroads, Futures and Rebound included in an APS school for October Count purposes were removed for this report.

**Total Enrollments** Includes all students that were enrolled in school during the year. Students leaving and then returning would be counted as more than one enrollment. "No shows," student enrollments that ended on or prior to the 11<sup>th</sup> day of school based on the district's conventional calendar (August 25, 2015), are not included. Edna and John W. Mosley P-8 was on a construction calendar for the 2015-16 school year. September 25, 2015 is the 11<sup>th</sup> day for that school.

$$\text{Total Enrollments} = \text{Stable Enrollments} + \text{Transient Enrollments}$$

**Stable Enrollments** Includes all students that were enrolled on or prior to the 11<sup>th</sup> day of school and remained the entire school year without changes in enrollment or who graduated during the school year.

**Transient Enrollments** Includes all students that were enrolled or transferred after the 11<sup>th</sup> day of school.

**Stability Rate** Calculated by dividing the number of stable enrollments by the total number of student enrollments.

$$\left( \frac{\text{Stable Enrollments}}{\text{Total Enrollments}} \right)$$

**Transiency Rate** Calculated by dividing the number of transient enrollments by the total number of student enrollments.

$$\left( \frac{\text{Transient Enrollments}}{\text{Total Enrollments}} \right)$$

$$\text{Stability Rate} + \text{Transiency Rate} = 100\%$$

### DATA

The information used in the 2015-16 K-12 Stability and Transiency (Mobility) Report was downloaded from Infinite Campus on June 28, 2016. The data includes Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in a traditional APS school. Preschool students were not included in this report. "No shows" were not included in the student enrollment totals. Students enrolled in July and August needed to remain through the 11<sup>th</sup> day of school (August 25, 2015) in order to be counted. Students graduating throughout the year were included as stable students provided they started school on or prior to the 11<sup>th</sup> day of school. Ascent, Crossroads, Futures, and Rebound students enrolled in these programs after the 11<sup>th</sup> day of school were not included in this report.
