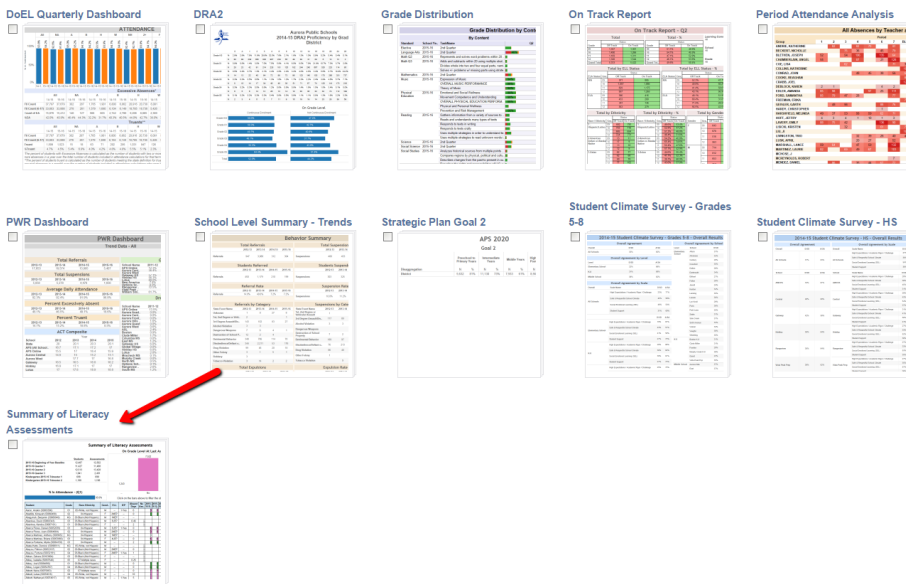

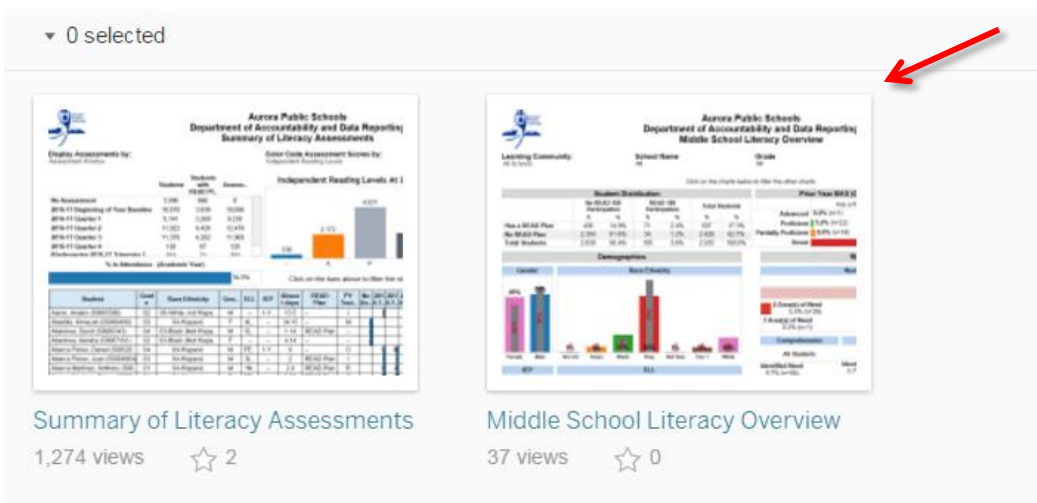
Step 2 - Select the Summary of Literacy Assessments



From the Home Screen, select the Summary of Literacy Assessments Workbook

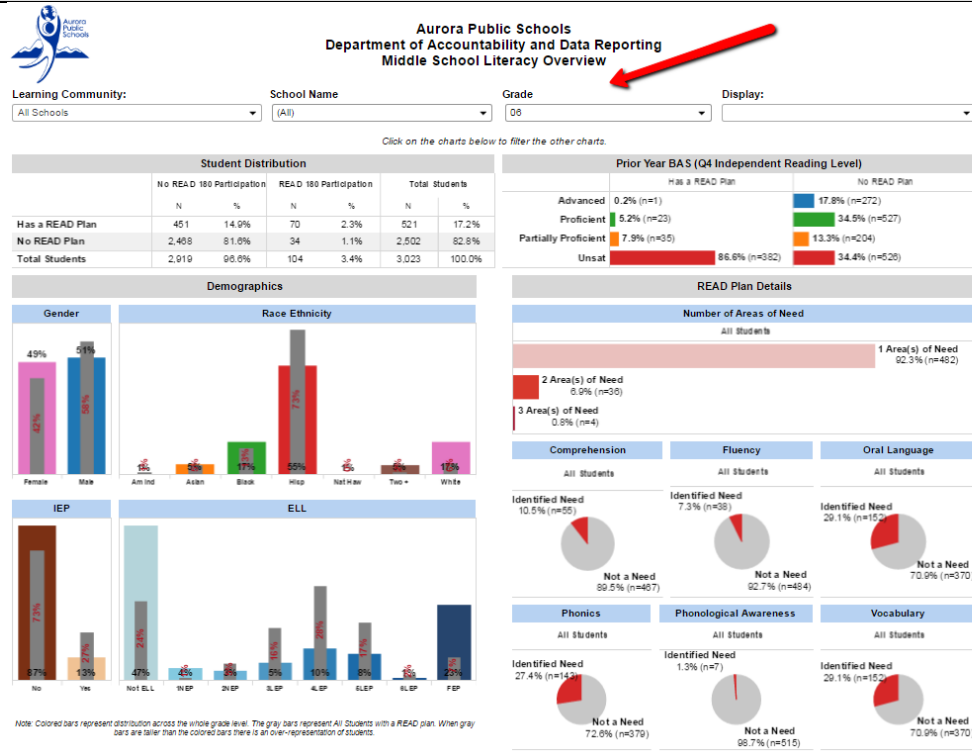
- This workbook provides an overview of 6th grade students including demographic variables, READ Plan variables, and designation of students participating in READ 180.

This workbook currently contains 2 workbooks- One is for Elementary and the other is for Middle school.

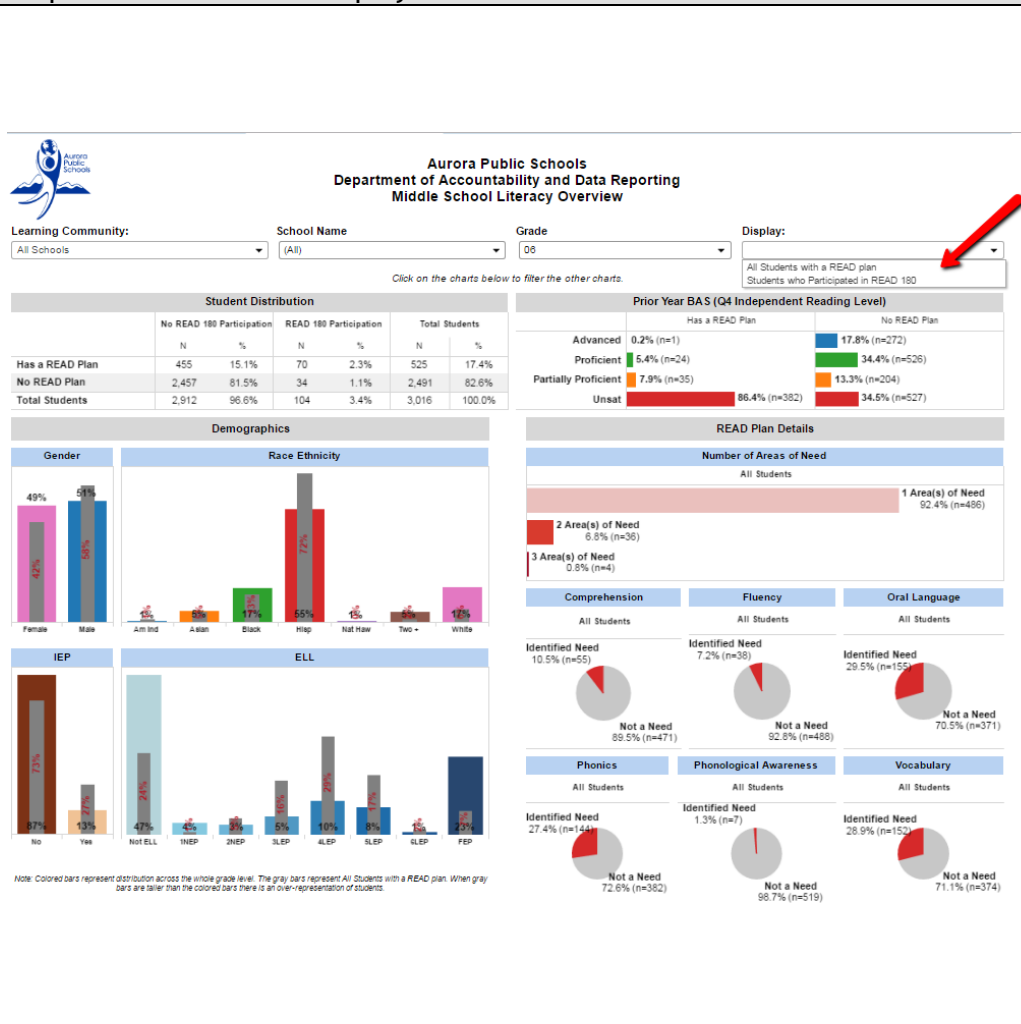
Step 4 - Using the Middle School Literacy Overview

- Students not on a READ Plan

Step 6 - What each chart identifies: Student Distribution

Student Distribution shows the number and percentage of students (as defined in the filters and display) that:

- Have a READ Plan and are not participating in READ 180
- Do not have a READ Plan and are not participating in READ 180
- Have a READ Plan and are participating in READ 180
- Do not have a READ plan, but are participating in READ 180

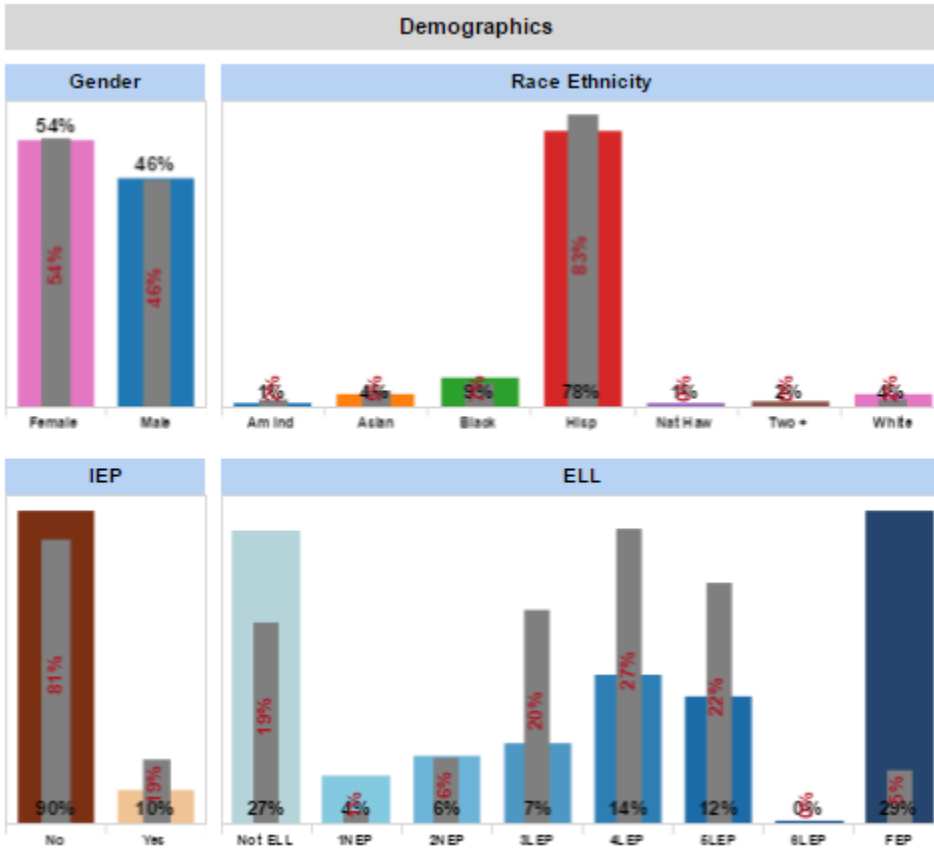
Step 7 - What each chart identifies: Prior Year BAS (Q4 Independent Reading Level)

Prior Year BAS shows the number and percentage of students (as defined in the filters and display) who have a proficiency level of Advanced, Proficient, Partially Proficient and Unsatisfactory and:

- Have a READ Plan or
- Do not have a READ Plan

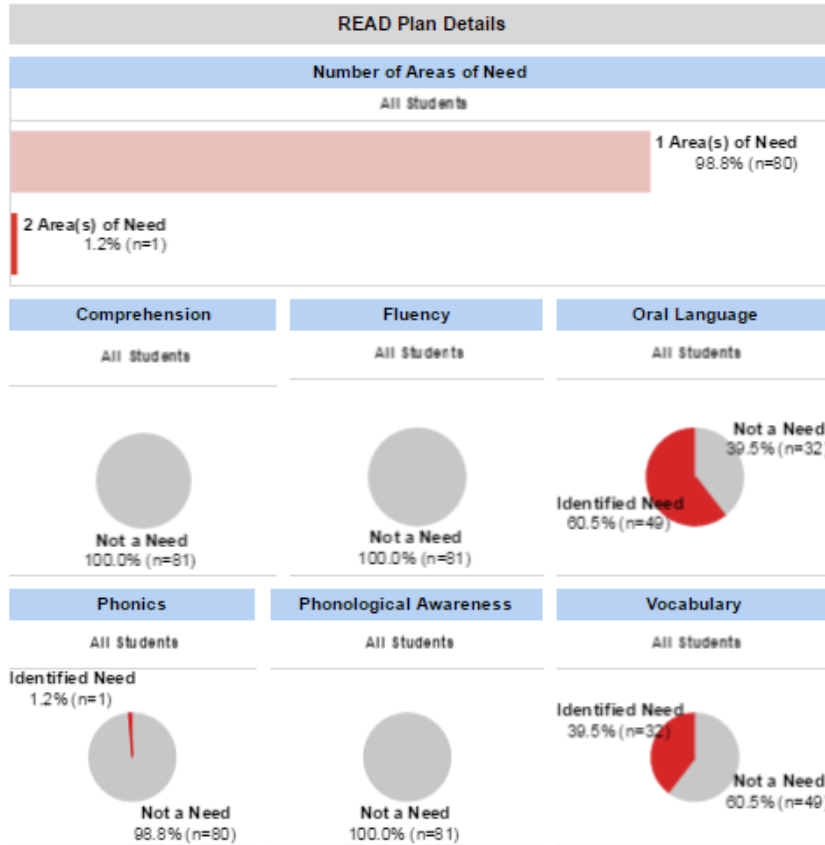
Step 8 - What each chart identifies: Demographics



Demographics shows the percentage of students (as defined in the filters and display) within each field.

Note: The Colored bars represent the distribution across the whole grade level. The gray bars represent All Students with a READ Plan. When gray bars are taller than the colored bars, there is an over-representation of students.

Step 9 - What each chart identifies: READ Plan Details



READ Plan Details shows:

- The number and percentage of students with one or more areas of need identified within their READ plans and
- The number and percentage of students who have goals within each area of need (Comprehension, Fluency, Oral Language, Phonics, Phonological Awareness, and Vocabulary)
